Many of the horses used at Round-up H.O.P.E. are rescued and donated animals. The care to keep them healthy is costly. In order to continue to provide a safe and healthy environment for our children and horses, we rely on donations from our generous supporters. Every contribution is greatly appreciated.

Parents of special needs children are often heavily burdened financially, due to high medical expenses, leaving them unable to afford riding therapy.

To give the gift of riding to one of our therapeutic riders once a week is \$160 for one month, \$480 quarterly, or \$1920 annually.

A \$250 donation allows us to feed, shoe, stable and provide veterinary care for one of our therapy horses for one month or \$3,000 annually.
